## **PURPOSE OF THE MEGHAN BOMFORD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

To provide annually a minimum of two scholarships towards post-secondary education for ringette players who have demonstrated a strong commitment to the sport of ringette and a need for funding assistance. One award will be in the amount of \$1000 and the second will be in the amount of \$500.

The awarding of the first bursary will be based on need, commitment to ringette and lastly, academic standing. The second bursary will be awarded completely at random by pulling a name from a list of all qualified applicants.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE**

Scholarship funds must be applied to the academic year in which the scholarship was awarded.

## **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?**

Application for the Meghan Bomford Memorial Scholarship may be made by athletes who are or have been registered in Ringette Calgary or have participated in the Ringette Calgary league. Student Athletes must be attending a post-secondary institution full time during the application year.

Applicants must have demonstrated a commitment to their education and must meet the admission standards of the educational institution or program specified.

The chosen applicant will be someone who has been a positive role model in the sport of ringette, who best demonstrates sustained commitment, dedication and passion for the sport of ringette. Aside from playing ringette, applicants may also demonstrate commitment through, coaching, officiating and/or other volunteer activities, and who has earned the respect of his/her teammates, coaches, and officials for his/her fair play, teamwork, and sportsmanship. The successful applicant must demonstrate current registration at a post-secondary training program, college, or university.
